This innovation allows us to close the loop in our production cycle, ensuring that nothing is wasted and all by-products are fully utilized. The creation of these spelt husk pellets required a significant investment of 2% of our annual revenue, underscoring our commitment to sustainable innovation.

By constantly refining our processes and turning waste into value, we've gained a competitive advantage in both the grain and pellet markets. But beyond profitability, our approach allows us to provide better compensation to our farmers, helping them thrive as key partners in this sustainable ecosystem.
